Located in the heart of the Tillamook State Forest, the Tillamook Forest Center offers interpretive exhibits, family nature programs, K-12 field trips and facility rentals. It's fun, accessible and free. Discover lessons of the past, the present and the future of this dynamic forest with hands-on learning and a sense of exploration you'll find nowhere else.

Learn about the history of the Tillamook Burn through interactive displays. Sense the power of a forest fire in the Tillamook Burn Theater. Imagine spotting a smoke column from our 40-foot lookout tower. View salmon returning up the Wilson River from the 250-foot long suspension bridge. Follow the footsteps of the area's first settlers at the nearby Smith Homestead Day Use Area. Join staff on a tour of the surrounding forest to learn about wildflowers, a settler's life, trees, and wildlife. Or, make the Center your gateway to the forest and endless recreation opportunities.
